#### FMCSA Proposes Changes to ELD Regulations

The Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) is reviewing potential changes to electronic logging device (ELD) regulations. The goal is to streamline compliance and reduce paperwork burdens for carriers and drivers. Stay tuned for updates on what this means for you!

#### Infrastructure Projects Affecting Oversize Loads

Several states are investing in major bridge and highway improvements, which could impact permitted routes. Key states to watch: Texas, Ohio, and California. If you're hauling oversize loads, be sure to check for updated routing requirements.


